

Rules of Payment at www.fitce2012.pl Website

1. The organizer of the FITCE 2012 conference and www.fitce2012.pl website shall be the Polish Association of Telecommunication Engineers seated in Warsaw, ul. Św. Barbary 2/1209, in cooperation with the Chair of Communication and Computer Networks, Poznań University of Technology seated in Poznań, ul. Polanka 3, hereinafter referred to as the "Organizers".
2. The Organizers may be contacted personally at the Organizers' office, by mail at the Organizers' postal address, by phone (+48 22 6591190), and by email (zarzad@sit.org.pl).
3. The financial service of the FITCE 2012 conference shall be ensured by the Polish Association of Telecommunication Engineers, seated in Warsaw, ul. Św. Barbary 2/1209. Address for correspondence ul. Kaliska 11/406, 02-316 Warszawa.
4. To participate in the conference, one is required to register at www.fitce2012.pl and pay a fee to the Organizers within the time limit defined at www.fitce2012.pl. The person who paid the FITCE 2012 conference fee shall be hereinafter referred to as the "Participant".
5. The FITCE 2012 participation fee may be paid as follows:
 - a. by payment card,
 - b. by bank transfer to the account indicated at www.fitce2012.pl
6. The www.fitce2012.pl website reserves the right to make available other forms of payment than those named under item 5, based on individual arrangements with Participants.
7. The online payments shall be serviced by eCard S.A. and the available payment forms shall include the following payment cards:
 - a. Visa
 - b. Visa Electron
 - c. MasterCard
 - d. Maestro
8. Each Participant shall have the right to withdraw from the contract for convenience within 10 (ten) days from fee payment, as per art. 7 section 1 of the law of 2 March 2000 concerning protection of certain consumer rights and liability for damage caused by a hazardous product (Journal of Laws of 2000 No. 22, item 271, as amended).
9. Within 30 days before the starting date of the FITCE 2012 conference each Participant shall have the right to withdraw from participation therein.
10. The fee paid for participation in the FITCE 2012 conference, less an administration fee of 50 Euro, shall be reimbursed to such a Participant within 14 days from the date of receiving by the Organizers of a written statement of withdrawal from the conference participation by such a Participant. In case of a payment card payment the amount shall be reimbursed directly to the Client's card. If such withdrawal is made within a time period shorter than 30 days before the starting date of the FITCE 2012 and/or the Participant fails to attend the conference, the fee shall not be reimbursed.
11. Any complaint shall be examined within 14 business days at the latest, counting from the date of receipt of the complaint by the Organizer.
12. Should the Organizers fail to take a stand as regards the complaint filed by a Participant within 14 business days counting from the date of receipt of the complaint by the Organizers, it shall be assumed that the Organizers found the complaint justified.
13. According to the law dated 29 August 1997 concerning protection of personal data (and amendments that followed) we guarantee protection of all personal data that have been obtained in the course of the organizational process of the FITCE 2012 conference and registration of data.

14. The Organizers shall assure that personal data of Participants are processed only for the purpose of implementation of the FITCE 2012 conference.
15. In relevant cases and based on the applicable law of 29 August 1997 concerning protection of personal data (Journal of Laws, of 2002, No. 101, item 926, as amended), a Participant shall have the right to demand supplementing, updating, correcting of his/her personal data, ceasing of their processing on temporary or permanent basis or deleting thereof, should they be incomplete, outdated, untrue or have been obtained illegally or have become redundant for implementation of the purpose, as well as to file a written request to stop processing of his/her personal data.
16. The Organizers shall neither process nor make any data concerning Participants available to other entities.
